

FAMILY PRESERVATION SERVICES



PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS

- Short-term, tailored and evidence-based interventions that 'wrap' around a family through in-home and community-based supports.
- Focused on stabilizing families in crisis, structuring for safety, and diminishing service barriers with a single agency's team of providers.
- Based on a per diem payment structure, families can access a variety of programs/ services including, but not limited to:
 - Home-Based Therapy
 - Case Management
 - Transportation
 - Education
 - Parenting
 - Life Skills
 - Substance Abuse
 - Domestic Violence
 - Budget Review and Financial Assistance
 - Access to Group Therapy
 - Safety Planning
 - Weekly Safety Checks
- Family Preservation strengthens protective factors and supports community resourcing.
- Participating families are supported by evidence-based interventions including but not limited to Trauma-Focused Cognitive Behavior Therapy, Motivational Interviewing, 1, 2, 3 Magic, and Seeking Safety curriculums.

WHAT TO EXPECT

WITHIN 48 HOURS OF REFERRAL

- GJR in IN will contact the family to schedule the first face-to-face visit.
- Collaboration with Family Case Manager (FCM) regarding needs/goals/plan of treatment safety.

FIRST FACE-TO-FACE MEETING

- Intake documents completed.
- Family needs, protective factors and family strengths identified.
- Safety check completed.
- Safety plan and treatment plan developed.
- Identify need for concrete funds.

WITHIN THE FIRST 7 DAYS OF FACE-TO-FACE MEETING

- Safety plan, treatment plan, and initial evaluation uploaded to Kidtraks.
- A budget will be created with the family.
- Community resources will be explored.
- Ongoing collaboration with the FCM regarding updates and family engagement.

WEEKLY/MONTHLY SERVICES

- Weekly home safety checks.
- Collaboration with FCM.
- Continued evidence-based intervention toward treatment plan goal attainment.
- Development of protective factors.
- Monthly updates of finances and budget.
- Monthly summary of services report sent to KidTraks.
- Weekly/bi-weekly/monthly individual and group supervision with clinically licensed supervisors.

ONGOING SERVICES

- Community resourcing for long term supports.
- Service frequency assessed and adjusted based on need.
- Attendance at court.
- Treatment team collaboration.
- Child and family team meetings.
- Attend or support other appointments upon request.
